Online Free School Meals Applications

Plymouth City Council has developed an online Free School Meals form for parents and carers to apply for free school meals in Plymouth. After a successful trial, it is being rolled out to all schools, start date 23rd April 2019. The benefits of the online application are that the parent can apply in the comfort of their own home, at a time that suits them. If you are not sure if you would be eligible, it is an easy way for parents to establish eligibility without the face to face conversation, which some people may prefer. The online form is more secure than the paper forms, as everything is done online.
