We have been asked by the Westcountry Schools Trust to pass on the following information regarding Brexit.

'As I am sure you will be aware, the UK government is planning to take the UK out of the European Union. In preparation for this, we are writing to all parents to ensure that both they and their children are prepared for the UK leaving the EU. If you are an EU, EEA or Swiss citizen, you and your family can apply to the EU Settlement Scheme to continue living in the UK after 30 June 2021. If your application is successful, you will be awarded either 'settled' or 'pre-settled' status. It is very important to bear in mind that you will also need to make an application for your child(ren) if they are not UK citizens. You may be able to stay in the UK without applying - for example, if you are an Irish citizen or have indefinite leave to remain (also known as 'permanent residency'). At the date of this letter, the deadline for applying is 30 June 2021. However, if the UK leaves the EU without a deal, then the deadline for applying will be 31 December 2020. #### Friends of Glen Park AGM


