## Westcountry School Trust Update

As part of our continued school improvement strategy, Westcountry Schools Trust (WeST) have recently undertaken a review of how school to school support work is organised across the Trust. From January 2020, Glen Park Primary will form part of a new geographically organised 'Plympton Hub' alongside 4 other

local primary schools in the Trust. Two other Hubs have been established in Devon and Plymstock. To support this new model, Hub Leaders have been appointed to coordinate and support work across the schools in each Hub. I will be taking on the role of Hub Leader for the Plympton Hub and from January, be reducing my working days at Glen Park to 4 days a week. Mrs Duncan will take responsibility for the


#### Year 5 visit to Plympton Academy
